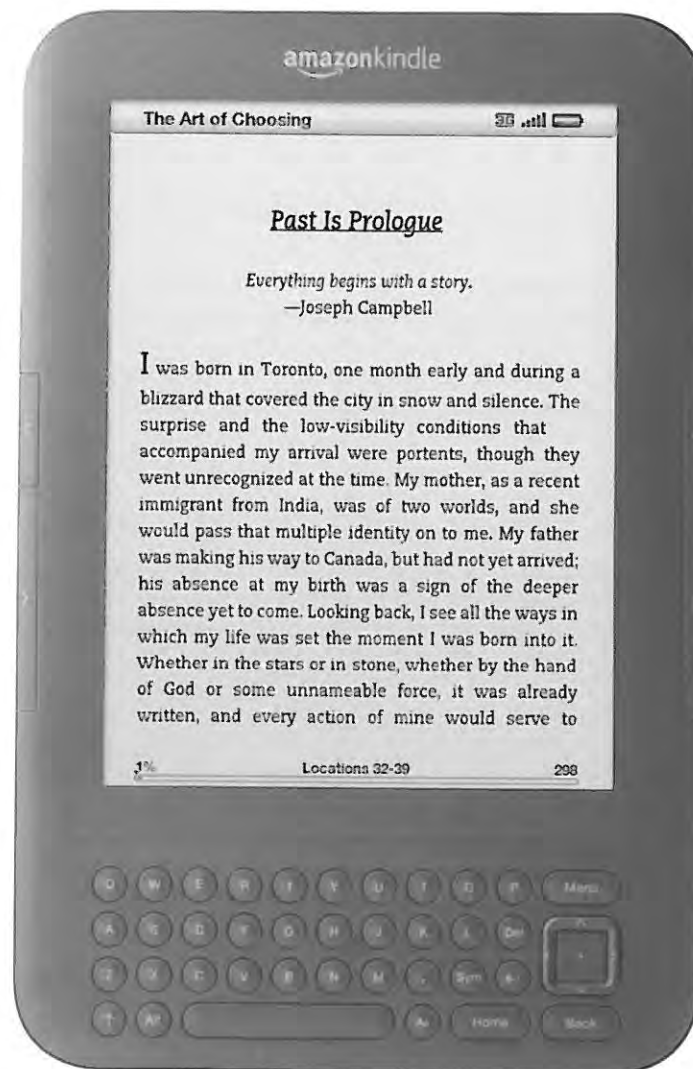


# Kindle eBooks @ Your Library: A Guide



## What you need to get started

In order to start using downloadable books with your Kindle, you will need to be logged in to your Amazon.com account.

Steps:

1. Visit <http://www.amazon.com>.
2. If you do not yet have an Amazon.com account, follow these steps:
  - a. Click “Start Here.”



- b. Enter your e-mail address and select “No, I am a new customer.” Then click “Sign in using our secure server.”

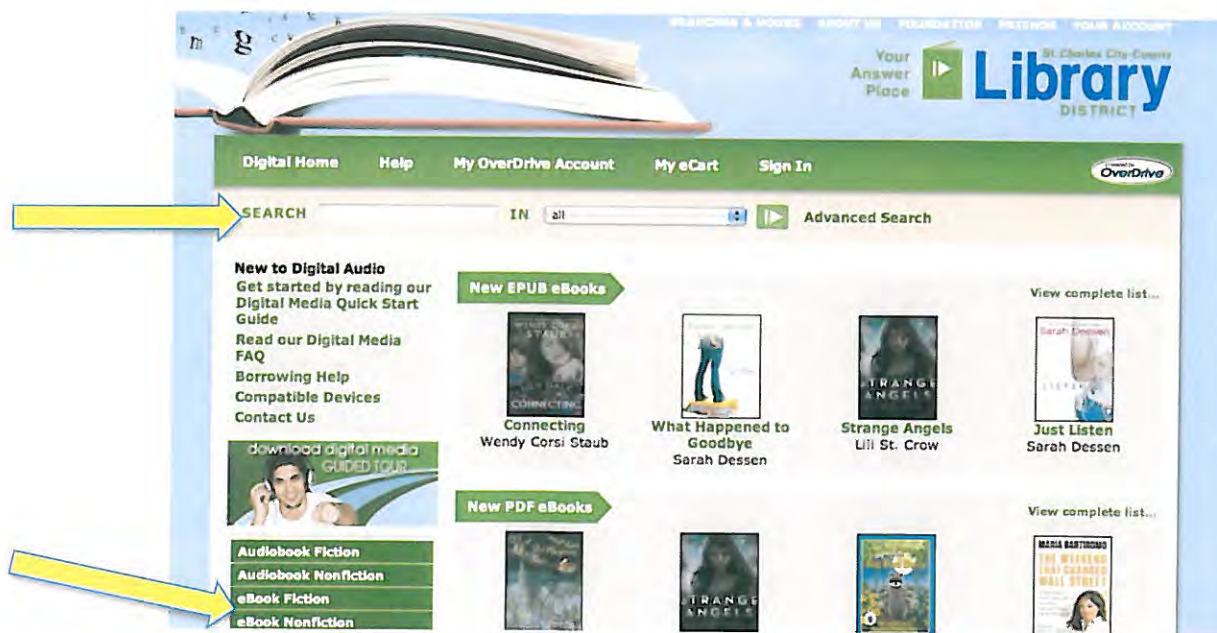
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
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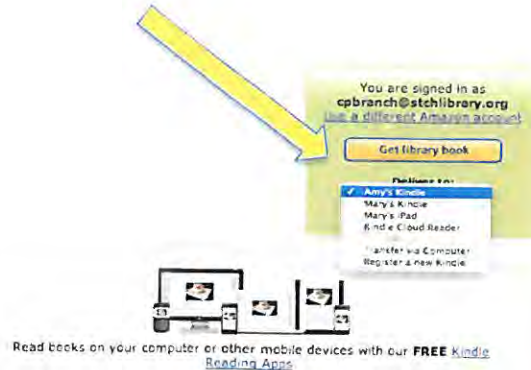
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
